- ❖ All the subjects will have the assessment of different skills as specified by the CBSE (Skills and the frequency of the assessment of the skills are mentioned in this policy. Scores for each skill will be shown separately in the score sheets)

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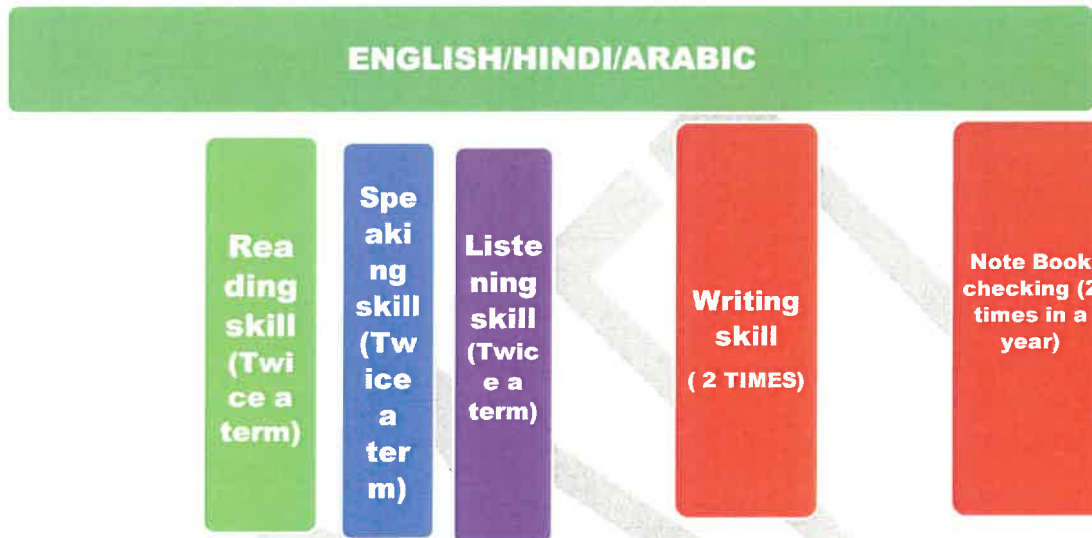


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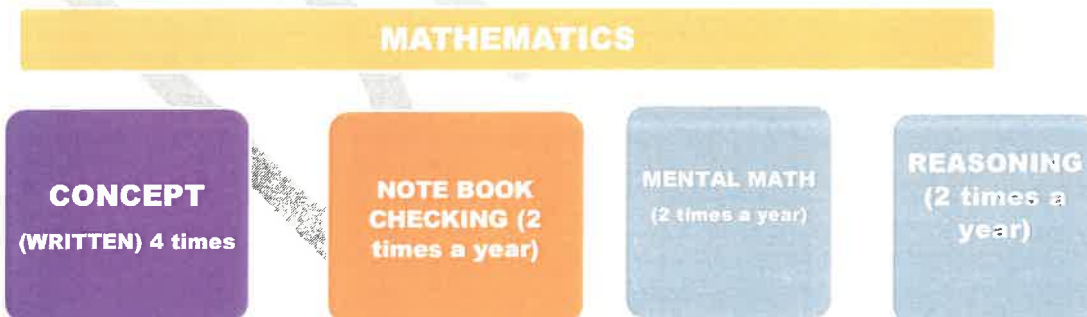

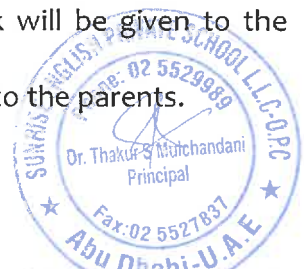

- ❖ Assessment of writing skills will be conducted 4 times in a year.
- ❖ Evaluation of the each tests will be returned in 7-10 days.
- ❖ Separate files should be maintained by the students to keep the answer sheets of the written assessment. The file should be readily available for the teachers to verify.
- ❖ Teachers are instructed to use rubrics for the assessment of various skills.
- ❖ Marks of different skills for a term will be calculated and converted into grades.
- ❖ These grades for each skill will be shown on the report card.
- ❖ Grade list/mark list must be handed over to the class teachers before the open house and answer papers must be distributed in the class by the concerned subject teachers and the answers will be discussed in the class.
- ❖ Co-scholastic areas like Physical Education, Art, Music, Dance, etc. should be provided with grades for concerned skills mentioned in the rating scale once in a term.

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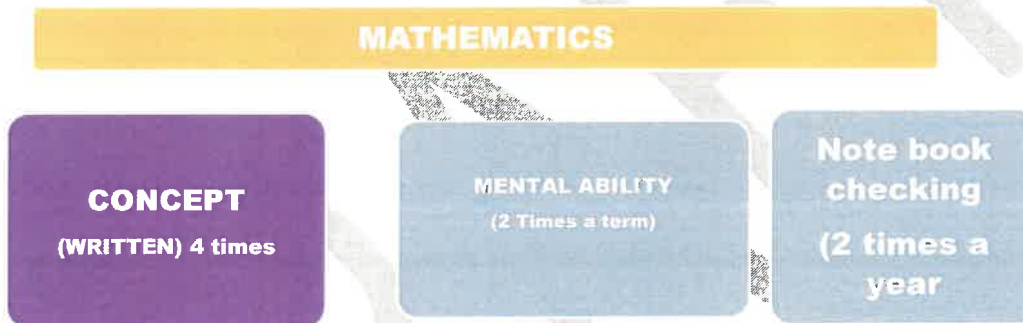

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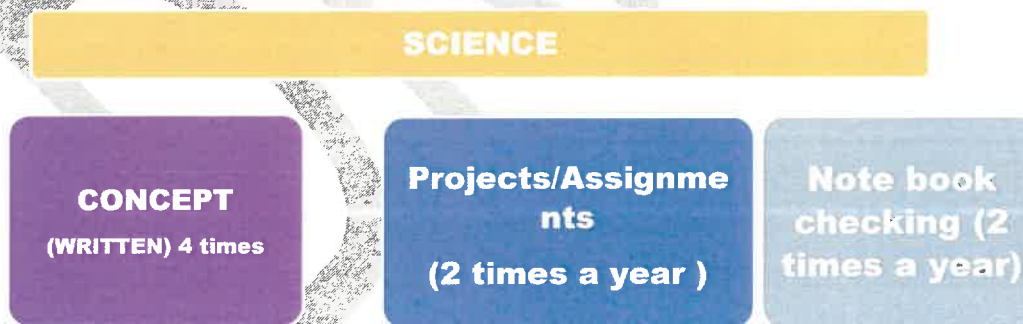

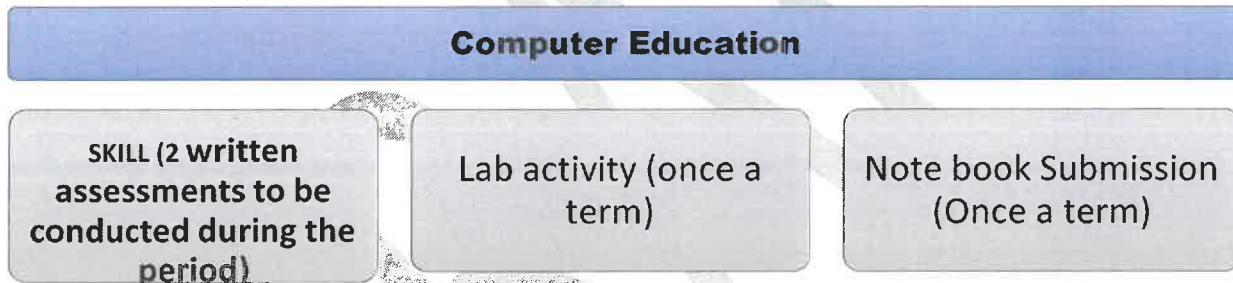

- ❖ There will be two terms in an academic year. (First term- April, May, June and September)
- ❖ Second term- October, November, January, February and March.

1. FORMATIVE ASSESSMENTS:

- Two Formative Assessments will be conducted in an academic year.
- Formative Assessment 1 will be conducted during the first term. Formative Assessment 2 will be conducted during the second term.
- All the Formative Assessments will be conducted out of 30 marks.

2. SUBJECT ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES (SEA) (5 marks)

These are subject-specific activities aimed at enhancing the understanding and skills of the students. These activities are to be carried out throughout the term and the evaluation will be done along with FA's.



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- All the below-mentioned will be the subject enrichment activities conducted throughout the term and the mark entry will be done once in a term out of 5 marks.
- Following are the subject enrichment activities recommended by the CBSE
 1. Languages - Assessment of Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing
 2. Science - Practical Lab work, Investigatory Projects, Quiz, Assignments and Case Studies
 3. Mathematics - Assignments, Projects, and quiz.
 4. Social Science - Map work, Project work and Case studies

4. TERM-END EXAMINATIONS

- Two examinations (Term-1 and Term-2) will be conducted in an academic year for 80 marks
- The Term-1 Examination will be conducted during the month of September-October for 80 marks with the syllabus covered till the end of the first term.
- The Term-2 Examination will be conducted in the month of March for 80 marks with syllabus coverage as mentioned below:
 1. Grade 6 – Syllabus of second term.
 2. Grade 7 – syllabus of second term
 3. Grade 8 – syllabus of second term.
 - (significant topics will be decided by the respective departments and notify the same in the Year Plan)

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PROMOTION

The aggregate marks of the term-1 and Term-2 (each out of 100, totaling 200 marks) will be converted to a score out of 100. Students will be promoted if they score a minimum of 33% in the main subjects, 50% in Arabic and Islamic Studies, and 60% in UAE M.S.C.St.

CO-SCHOLASTIC ASSESSMENT FOR GRADES 6 TO 8

For the holistic development of the student, co-curricular activities in the following areas will be carried out by the teachers and will be graded term- wise on a 5-point grading scale (A= Outstanding, B=Excellent, C- Very Good, D-Good and E = Can do better). The aspect of regularity, sincere participation, output, and teamwork be the generic criteria for grading in the following co-scholastic activities:

- Work education: Skill based activities resulting in goods or service useful to the community
- Art education: Visual and performing Arts
- Health and physical education (sports and Games)
- Discipline: Students will be assessed for the discipline which will be based on the factors like attendance, sincerity, behavior, values, and tidiness, respectfulness for rules and regulations, attitude towards society, nation and others. Grading of discipline will be done term-wise on a 5-point grading scale (A= Outstanding, B=Excellent, C- Very Good, D-Good and E = Can do better)

1. PERIODIC ASSESSMENTS:

- Two Periodic Assessments will be conducted in an academic year for 30 marks and the best of the two will be considered for promotion.

3. SUBJECT ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES:

- Three subject enrichment activities will be done in an academic year for 5 marks and the average marks of the best 2 (5 marks) will be considered for final mark entry. (Refer CBSE Circular No: Acad 05/2017 Dated 31/01/2017 for more details on subject enrichment activities.)

3. PORTFOLIO ASSESSMENT 5 marks

Classwork, peer assessment, self-assessment, achievements of student in the subject, reflections, narrations, journals, etc. are assessed for 5 marks.

4. MULTIPLE ASSESSMENT 5 marks

Quizzes, class tests, record and project works, ALS for languages, art integrated activity, assignments & research works etc.



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EXAMINATIONS

- The school will internally conduct the first term exam for Grades 9 & 10 for 80 marks
- The annual examination for grade 9 will be conducted for 80 marks in the month of February.
- The annual examination for Grade 10 will be conducted by the CBSE.

PROMOTION

Promotion for grade 9& 10 will be based on the following:

TERM 1

- Internal Assessment – P1-30 marks(convert into 5)= 5 marks + Portfolio assessment 5 marks + Multiple Assessments 5 marks + Subject Enrichment 5 marks = 20 marks
- Half yearly examination – 80 marks
- Total – Internal Assessment – 20 marks + Half yearly exam 80 marks = 100 marks

TERM 2

Internal Assessment – P2 30 marks (convert into 5)= 5 marks + Portfolio assessment 5 marks Multiple Assessments 5 marks + Subject Enrichment 5 marks = 20 marks

Annual examination – 80 marks

Grade 10 will have two Pre-Board Exams in addition to all other exams.

Total – Internal Assessment – 20 marks + Half yearly exam 80 marks = 100 marks

- 50% of the score of Term 1 exam (40 marks) + 50% of the score of Term-2 exam (40 marks) = 80 marks
- Cumulative marks – Internal assessment 20 marks + the score of the term exam 80 marks = 100 marks
- Students whose score is 33% and above will be promoted to the next highest level.

PROMOTION FOR GRADE 11 WILL BE BASED ON THE RESULTS OF THE BOARD EXAM

(Provisional admission to grade 11 may be granted before the grade 10 CBSE results are declared)

Use of Assessment Data: Approach and utilization.

1. Internal Assessment: School conducts four internal assessments for all classes. The assessment data will be well coordinated to plan further intervention plans for students in need of reinforcement of concepts. Pull out sessions will be planned for those who require special attention in respective subjects.
2. International Assessment: School conducts ADEK Mandated assessments like IBT, PISA, TIMSS, PIRLS etc. to gauge the standard of the students. These assessment data are collated to make further modifications in curriculum and methodology of teaching. Reteaching or remediation is sought depending on the requirements.

Data-Driven Decision Making

Instructional Planning: We use this assessment data to identify student strengths and weaknesses, guiding differentiated instruction and teaching.

Curriculum Adjustment: We analyse trends in assessment data to refine and adjust the curriculum, ensuring alignment with learning standards and addressing areas where students consistently struggle.

Personalized Learning

- Individualized Learning Plans: We develop personalized learning plans based on each student's assessment data, catering to their specific needs, learning pace, and style.
- Intervention plans: We implement remedial classes for specific group teaching.
- Student Engagement and Responsibility of Learning
- Goal Setting: We involve students in setting their own learning goals based on their assessment data, fostering a sense of ownership and motivation.
- Feedback and Reflection: We provide timely and constructive feedback based on assessment data, encouraging students to reflect on their learning and progress.
- Parent Involvement
- Reporting: We share assessment data with parents in a clear and accessible format, helping them understand their child's progress and areas for improvement.

PROMOTION and DETENTION POLICY

School religiously abides by the promotion policy of the ADEK and the CBSE. A student must appear for all the assessments. Students must score 33% aggregate in all the core subjects to qualify for promotion.

- Promotion to Grade 10 will be granted only to students who meet ADEK requirements: a minimum of 33% aggregate score in each of the five main subjects, and a minimum of 60% aggregate in U.A.E.M.S.C St, Arabic, and Islamic Studies.



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- Provision of grace marks up to 3 marks subject to the condition that the student has failed in one subject with a margin of 3 marks.
- Students in G9 & 11 will be given retest if they fail in two subjects.
Students in grade 9 & 11 will be detained if they fail in more than two subjects.

DETENTION PROCEDURE

- (1) No student will be retained if retained previously in that same grade/year.
- (2) A student will not be retained more than twice during his/her school career.
- (3) All students in KG to Grade 8 will be promoted to the next grade/year level, except in rare circumstances.
- (4) Students with special needs will not be retained. If a student with special needs is not making the expected progress, the objectives in their Independent Education Plan (IEP) will be adjusted.
- (5) School reports showing progress or (lack of) over two or more years
- (6) The school's curriculum
- (7) The social and developmental impact
- (8) The school's capacity to provide an improved learning experience and support
- (9) If the student has been previously retained
- (10) If the student has been assessed for special education needs to determine if their learning needs would be better met by an IEP

CHANGING THE OPTIONAL SUBJECTS

1. No candidate shall be permitted to change his/her subject of study after CBSE registration.
2. The candidate shall not offer a subject in Class XII that she/he has not studied and passed in Class XI.

DIVISION OF ACADEMIC SESSION

1. First term (April to September)
2. Second term (October to March)

Admission to Examinations

No candidate who has been expelled or is under the punishment of rustication or is debarred for appearing in or taking an examination for any reason whatsoever shall be admitted to the All India/Delhi Senior School Certificate Examinations conducted by the Board.

The candidate shall complete the required percentage of attendance (75%) for Class XI and XII as per Examination Byelaws of the Board to make her eligible for the examinations conducted by the Board. As per ADEK Chapter 14 Policy 55 on absence, a child should have 90% attendance for promotion.





SCHEME OF EXAMINATIONS

1. Class XI examination shall be conducted by the school.
2. The Board will conduct the external examinations at the end of Class XII.

PERIODIC ASSESSMENTS

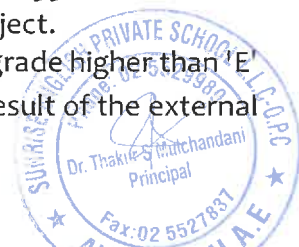
1. There will be Two PERIODIC ASSESSMENTS (PAs) in an academic year (one PA in term 1 and one in term 2)
2. PAs will be conducted for 30 marks for all the core subjects
3. A separate timetable will be issued for PAs
4. BLA (Baseline assessment) will be conducted at the beginning of the academic year.

Grade XII will have two Pre- Board exams in addition to all other exams and assessments.

1. The Board shall examine all subjects except Arabic, General Studies, Work Experience, Physical and Health Education, which will be assessed internally by the schools and Grading will be done on a 9-point scale.
2. In all subjects examined by the Board, a student will be given one paper each carrying 80 marks for 3 hours. However, in subjects requiring practical examinations, there will be a theory paper (50/60/70/80 marks) and practical examinations (50/40/30/20 marks) as required in the syllabi and courses.
3. In Work Experience, General Studies, and Physical and Health Education, the Schools will maintain cumulative records of student's periodical achievements and progress during the year. These records are subject to the scrutiny of the Board as and when deemed fit.

GRADING AND PASS CRITERIA

1. Assessment of theory/practical papers of main subjects shall be in numerical scores. In the case of internal assessment subjects, only grades shall be shown.
2. The qualifying marks in each subject of external examination shall be 33%. However, in a subject involving practical work, a candidate must obtain 33% marks in the theory and 33% marks in the practical separately in addition to 33% marks in aggregate, to qualify in that subject.
3. A candidate will be eligible to get the pass certificate of the Board if she gets a grade higher than 'E' in all subjects of internal assessment unless she is exempted. Failing this, the result of the external examination will be withheld but not for a period of more than one year.





4. To be declared as having passed the examination, a candidate shall obtain a grade higher than E (i.e., at least 33% marks) in all the five subjects of external examination in the main or at the end of the compartmental examination. The pass marks in each subject of external examination shall be 33%. In the case of a subject involving practical work, a candidate must obtain 33% marks in theory and 33% marks in practical separately in addition to 33% marks in aggregate to qualify in that subject.

ABSENT FOR THE ASSESSMENT

A student must appear in all the assessments conducted by the school/Board

PROMOTION DETENTION POLICY

A student must appear in all the assessments.

- Students must score 33% aggregate in all the core subjects to qualify for the assessment.
- Students must score a minimum 60% marks for Arabic and Islamic studies.
No retest will be conducted under any circumstances.
- 75% attendance is compulsory to be eligible for promotion to the next higher grade. As per ADEK policy of absence (Policy 55) a child should have a minimum of 90% attendance for promotion to the next higher grade.
- Only to those students who meet the above-mentioned requirements of CBSE. (33% Aggregate score in each subject, 33% in aggregate of all the subjects, and minimum D Grade for General studies, life skill and Health and Physical Education) will be qualified to be promoted.

EVALUATION OF ANSWER SHEETS

- ❖ The evaluation of the answer sheets should be completed within 10 days after the completion of the written assessment.
- ❖ Exchanged paper valuation is strongly recommended for all assessments and exams.
- ❖ Evaluation should be done by using a red ink pen.
- ❖ The tabular columns on the facing sheet of the answer booklet should be filled by all examiners. The entries should be checked, and counter-signed by the HODs. The total of marks should be rounded off and written in figures and words in the facing sheet. No answer script should be distributed to students without the dated signature of the examiners.
- ❖ Answer scripts should be distributed after all the assessments and exams. A discussion with the children on their areas of improvement should be initiated by each teacher while distributing the answer scripts.





- ❖ Mark entry sheets will be prepared by the concerned subject teachers to record the scoring during the evaluation.
- ❖ Teachers should hand over the mark list to the concerned class teachers within one week after the conduct of the written assessment. (before the open house)
- ❖ Class teachers will prepare the consolidated mark list and submit it to the Principal and Vice Principal.
- ❖ Teachers will enter the student's marks in the School portal and finally ESIS entry will be completed on time.
- ❖ Separate file should be maintained by the students to keep the answer sheets of the written assessment. All the answer papers will be given to the parents on the day of the open house.
- ❖ All the answers will be discussed in detail in the class after open house day.

❖ **OPEN-HOUSE (For all Grades)**

Separate Open House will be conducted for KG TO 11 and Grades 10 and 12. (Refer to the school Calendar)

- ❖ The class Teachers should have Marksheets and student files (answer sheets) with them during the open house for further reference.
- ❖ Each parent will be given 10 minutes to discuss the academic matters with the teachers.
- ❖ Always use positive and constructive remarks about all the students in your class.

REPORT CARD

- ❖ Report Cards will be prepared once every term by the school's digital campus.

This will be made available to Parents with prior notice.
