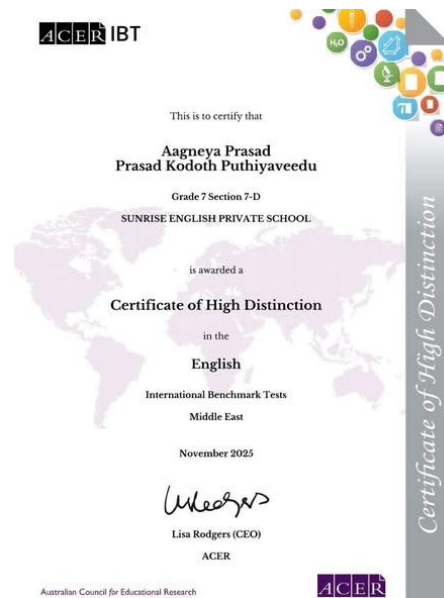
Poetic Heart event

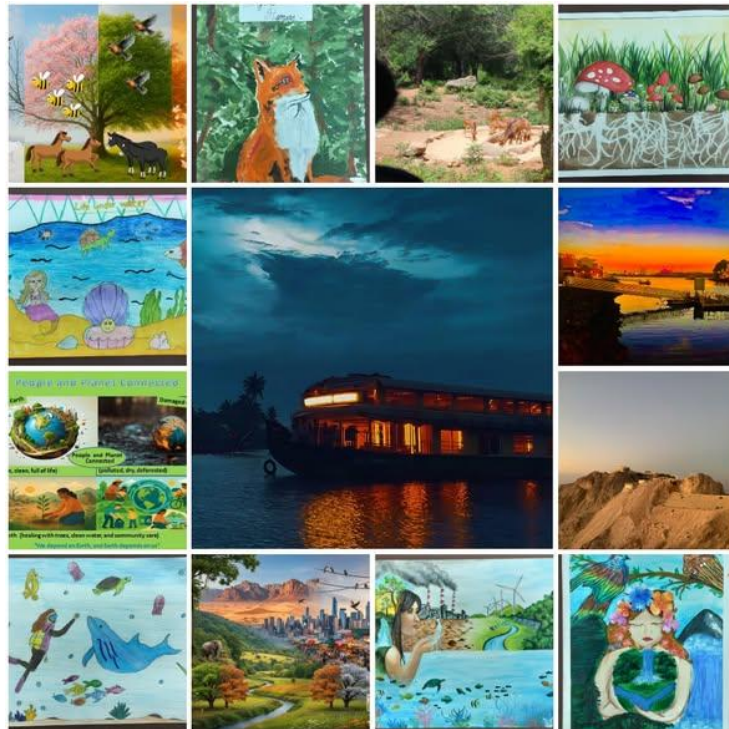
